Tom and Susan wardrobe starts dirty and then cleaner clothes are worn.

PROPS

All Props can be adapted according to staging.

Hand Props and food for Day Centre can be determined by staging.

Food props- Cake. Vegetables.

Chopping items. Vegetable peelers.

Plants and flowerpots.

Rucksacks, sleeping bags or cardboard, plastic sheeting for homeless.

Simulated drug equipment for Mick.

Simulated bags of drugs for dealers.

Bottles cider for Neil.

Book for Carol to read from.

Mugs for begging.

Food in a paper bag.

Lip gloss.

Notebooks and pens.

Shoe cloth for Neil.

Chocolate.

Bags of donated clothing.

Bowls of water and towels for foot care.

Bar of soap.

Takeaway pot of soup.

Pair of socks.

Guitar for Barry .

Optional knives for drug dealers.

Song lyrics can be written on large sheets for audience to see. Optional.

Soup kitchen. Urn optional or saucepan. Takeaway cups. Ladle optional.

Bread rolls or slices.

Household items / linen for Tom and Susan playing 'house'

Mobile phone for Sandra.

Comb for Sandra.
